

CLASSROOM RULES

1. No Food or Drinks.
2. No use of cosmetics (perfume, lotion, makeup, hairspray) during class.
3. No electronic devices (unless it is a calculator and approved by instructor) during class.
4. Be respectful, remain on task, attentive, cooperative at all times and raise your hand if you have a question .
5. Follow the school-wide tardy and discipline policy. Participation points will be deducted for unexcused tardies and/or defiance.
6. Be prepared for class with appropriate materials (paper, pencil, textbook...). Participation points may be deducted for not be prepared on time.
7. Read and make notes on course material that will be covered in class in advance, proof of completion may be asked at any time.
8. Stay organized and keep all your graded homework/notes/handouts in a safe place throughout the school year. A portfolio may be collected at the end of the semester.
9. Study and do all your homework. Advance notice of a test will be given, but quizzes may be given at any time.
10. Get all graded signed tests by parent/guardian within one week from the day the graded tests are returned to you. Participation points will be given for signed tests turned in on-time.
11. Check the website www.thepowerofmath.com and see how you are progressing in the class as grades will be updated often. Check the semester plan for any changes in the course and note test dates and prepare for them.
12. Be responsible. If you're absent check the website to see what you missed in class such as a new homework assignment or test.
 - If you miss a test due to an excused absence you should notify the instructor immediately upon your return and be ready to take it on your first day back from your absence.
 - A maximum of 2 exams can be made up due to excused absences, see me if further absences on test days occur.
 - Only homework not turned in due to an excused absence will be accepted. In this case turn in your homework on your first day back from your absence.
 - There are no make-ups for pop-quizzes, but may be excused (see instructor)
13. All assignments must be turned in the appropriate folder before the tardy bell the day that it is due and include the following before turning in for credit:
 - Name, date, period
 - Homework number, page number, problems assigned
 - Problems completed should have all work showing.
 - How many problems were completed should be written on top of the first page (somewhere next to your name). For example if you completed 20 problems out of 30 you would indicate 20/30.
